


Australia Awards

International Business Readiness in **the Fashion** and **Textiles Sector**



Australia Awards is seeking applications from candidates who work, or own businesses in the fashion and textiles sector and would like to develop their knowledge and skills in international business through attending **a two-week short course in Australia in March 2017**.

This course aims to encourage, support and advance the involvement of Indonesian business people in international business and connect the business with market opportunities for international expansion.

Through this two-week program, we would like to take you to explore the international markets and ways to make global expansion possible to your business.

To be selected for this course you must be:

- An entrepreneur/owner of a fashion or textile businesses or hold a senior position within an Indonesian fashion or textile company; organisations must be established and operating succesfully for five years or more
- Committed to prepare and develop a personal project as part of the course; engage actively and foster networks with multiple stakeholders, including in Australia and to disseminating learning from the course with colleagues and peer
- Have a minimum English language proficiency level equivalent of IELTS 5 / TOEFL 500

This is a fully funded scholarship. All course fees, travel, accomodation and per diems will be provided by Australia Awards.

Women and people with disability are encouraged to apply.
