### **Innovation and Entrepreneurship Award**

- Recognises achievement excellence in the areas of innovation and entrepreneurship. This can include; creation of a successful enterprise; creative new ideas/design/product for industry; innovative research findings; or recognition for outstanding entrepreneurial leadership.

### **Outstanding Young Alumni**


- Recognises the contribution made by an alumnus under 35 years of age in their chosen field that demonstrates integrity, initiative and innovation.
