

Australia Awards Short Course
Building Cyber Resilience: Managing
Risks and Leveraging Opportunities



Australia Awards in Indonesia invites applications for a short course on **Building Cyber Resilience: Managing Risks and Leveraging Opportunities**. The course provides policy makers and practitioners with insights into the latest developments and trends in the cyber threat landscape as well as Australia's cyber settings. It provides an opportunity for both Australia and Indonesia to build networks within and across a breadth of organisations with a role in cyber.

The course helps participants to:

- identify latest developments and trends in the cyber threat landscape
- develop knowledge and tools to improve cyber resilience, including cyber incident response and management
- examine Australia's cyber strategy, policy and operational settings
- explore the roles and responsibilities of Australia's policy, operational and technical agencies
- examine approaches to supporting resilient critical infrastructure from cyber threats
- examine approaches to protecting data from cyber threats
- examine approaches to combating cybercrime and cyber terrorism
- explore approaches to managing online harms, including in the context of online gambling and Australia's social media reforms
- examine responses to upholding international law and norms of responsible state behaviour in cyberspace
- explore the role of the private sector and public-private partnerships in responding to cyber threats, including through engagement with private companies
- explore approaches to raising cyber security awareness, including in the community
- build networks within and across a breadth of government agencies with a role in cyber
- identify collaboration opportunities between Indonesian and Australian stakeholders, including engagement with higher education institutions with cyber security offerings at their Indonesian campuses

The course will be delivered over 2 weeks in Australia in September or October 2025. A 3-day pre-course workshop will be held in Indonesia in August 2025. A post-course workshop will be held in Indonesia in January or February 2026.

Participants

The course is targeted to:

- vi) Coordinating Ministry of Political and Security Affairs (KemenkoPolkam)
- vii) Ministry of Defence
- viii) National Resilience Institute (Lemhanas)
- ix) Coordinating Ministry of Economic Affairs
- x) Ministry of Finance
- xi) Financial Services Authority (OJK)
- xii) Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KADIN)
- xiii) State-owned enterprises
- xiv) Academia, media and the private sector working on cyber and/or technology-related issues

General criteria for the applicants:

- Minimum three years' experience in a relevant role
- Government representatives: Echelon II to IV level
- Other sectors: preferably middle-management to upper-management level
- Diploma (D3) qualification or higher
- Application is endorsed by the applicant's supervisor
- Commitment to prepare and implement an Award Project, an individual or small group development project as part of the course
- Commitment to engage actively and foster networks with multiple stakeholders
- Commitment to disseminate learning from the course with counterparts and peers
- Applicants are expected to have professional working proficiency in English.

Women from disadvantaged backgrounds and people with disabilities are encouraged to apply.

Applicants currently holding a scholarship funded by the Australian Government are not eligible to apply for the short course.

This is a fully funded short course. Course fees, mobilisation costs, return airfares (domestic and international), insurance in Australia (OSHC), accommodation (in Indonesia and Australia), per diem, transport allowance and visa will be covered by Australia Awards in Indonesia.
