This addendum is openly available to all potential tenderers. It consists of responses to tenderers' questions.

QUESTION 1: We are keen to submit a response to this tender but need more detail regarding what 'waste management' consists of for the purpose of this tender. We understand the term to cover a range of materials and would like to clarify our understanding of the following request prior to proceeding: 'The course participants will explore circular economy principles, inclusive planning, and financing models and business models for integrated, sustainable solid waste management. The course will highlight Australia's Service Level Agreement (SLA) model to strengthen public-private partnerships and improve service accountability. Emphasis will also be placed on integrating GEDSI and climate change into waste management planning and delivery. Through case studies, peer learning, and cross-sector collaboration, the course aims to foster innovation and build capacity for achieving Indonesia's sustainable waste management objectives.'

**ANSWER 1:** This course considers waste management broadly as collecting, segregating, transporting, treating, and disposing of waste to minimise environmental impact and maximise resource recovery. The course also includes monitoring and regulating the process. **The course focuses on municipal waste**.
