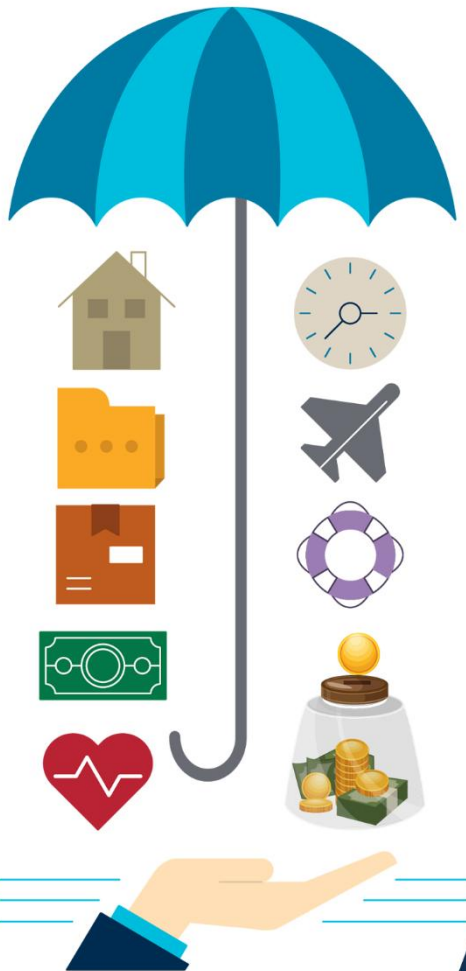

## Australia Awards Short Course

### *Mobilising Long-Term Capital through Insurance and Pension Reform in Indonesia*



Australia Awards in Indonesia invites applications for the **Australia Awards Short Course on Mobilising Long-Term Capital through Insurance and Pension Reform in Indonesia**.

The course will equip participants to:

- Analyse key reform priorities in insurance and pension sectors under UU P2SK, drawing on international and Australian experience and recent developments in Indonesia and the region
- Apply practical regulatory and supervisory tools to translate insurance and pension reform commitments into implementable actions
- Assess approaches to long-term capital mobilisation, including pension fund investment strategies, asset allocation, governance and fiduciary frameworks, and performance considerations
- Examine risk management and policyholder protection schemes, including in defined contribution pension schemes and mandatory insurance programs
- Explore inclusive and sustainable policy approaches, including the integration of GEDSI considerations, strengthened compliance and enforcement frameworks, and equitable access to insurance and pension products to enhance long-term financial resilience
- Strengthen regulatory capability through case studies, peer learning, and structured collaboration with industry and research institutions
- Draw on Australian regulatory, actuarial, and market experience to inform policy design and supervisory practice within participants' respective institutions
- Build networks with Australian institutions and experts for partnerships and future collaboration
- Create action plans (Award Project) to apply course learnings in their work and disseminate ideas

The course applies a range of learning methodologies: classroom sessions; case studies; site visits; discussion and planning sessions; simulations and role plays; and networking events. Additionally, the course participants will develop and implement an Award Project.

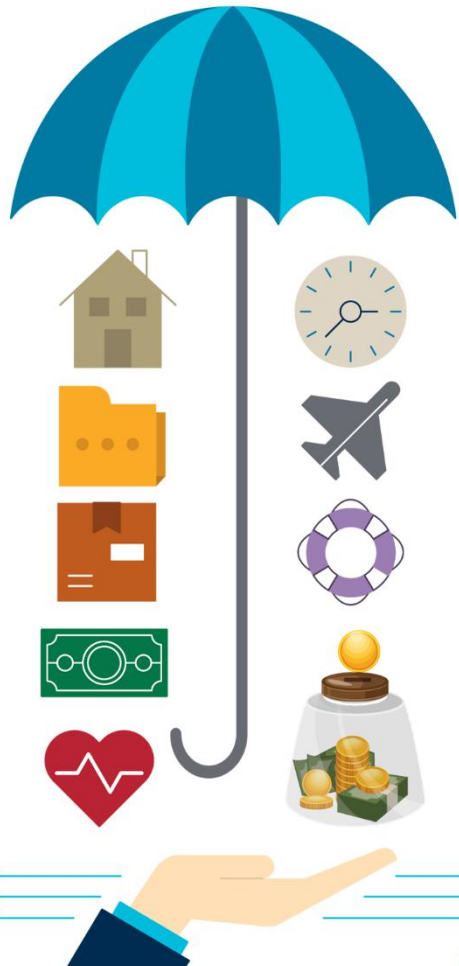

## Australia Awards Short Course

### *Mobilising Long-Term Capital through Insurance and Pension Reform in Indonesia*



The course consists three parts: a 2-week course in Australia and two 3-day workshops in Indonesia. The in-Australia course will be delivered in September 2026 (dates TBC). The pre-course workshop will be held in Indonesia in August 2026 (dates TBC) and the post-course workshop will be held in Indonesia in January or February 2027 (dates TBC).

The course is offered to decision makers and technical staff from:

- Otoritas Jasa Keuangan (Financial Services Authority)
- Ministry of Finance
- Lembaga Penjamin Simpanan (Deposit Insurance Corporation)
- Bappenas
- Coordinating Ministry for Economic Affairs
- Ministry of Manpower
- Social security institutions (e.g., BPJS Ketenagakerjaan, Taspen, Asabri)
- Industry and associations
- Think tanks and universities

Criteria for applicants:

- Application is endorsed by the supervisor
- Commitment to prepare and implement an Award Project as part of the course
- Commitment to engage actively and foster networks with multiple stakeholders
- Commitment to disseminate learning from the course with colleagues and peers
- Applicants are expected to have professional working proficiency in English

This is a fully funded short course. Course fees, travel, accommodation and allowance will be provided by Australia Awards in Indonesia.

Women from disadvantaged backgrounds and people with disabilities are strongly encouraged to apply.

An information session will be held virtually by Australia Awards in Indonesia on 11 May 2026 at 15:00 WIB. This session guides applicants through the application process, including the online applications, selection and interview.
